There are lots of ways to get involved:

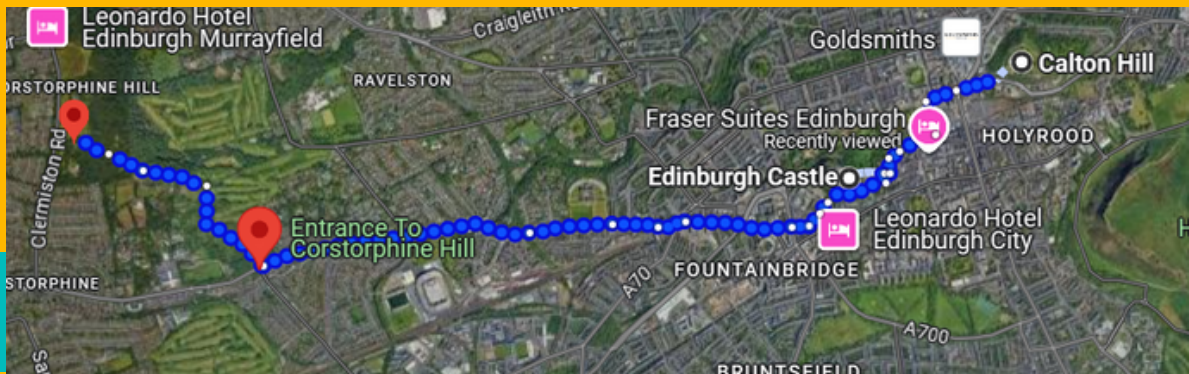
- Join us for part of the journey. The order in which the hills will be tackled are detailed in this guide and all are welcome to walk with us for as much or as little of the journey as you wish.

★ LEG 1 ★



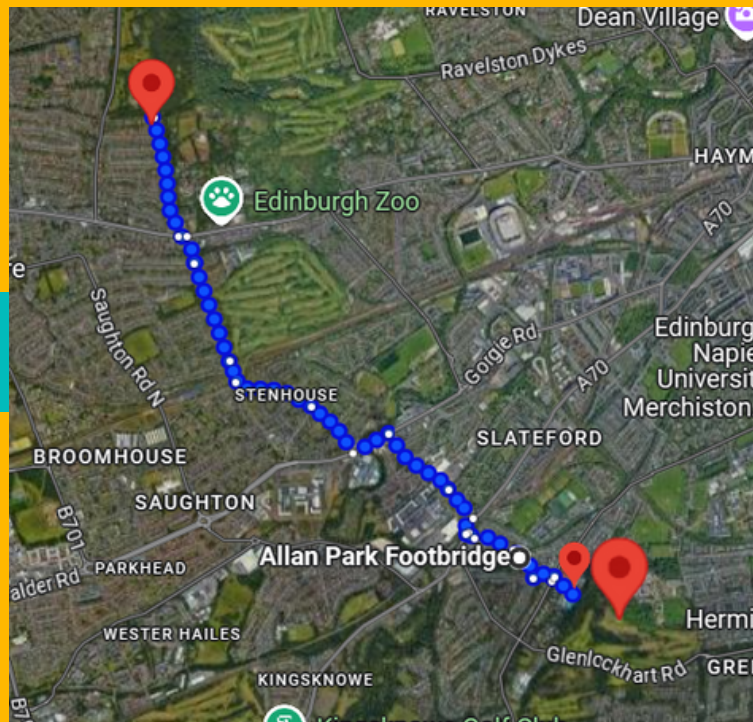
The start point will be Carlton Hill (Hill 1) where we will start at 9am.

From there we will walk to the Castle Esplanade (Hill 2) via Waterloo Place, North Bridge and the Royal Mile.

We will then walk down Johnston Terrace, Bread Street and Morrison Street before following Corstorphine Road to the Entrance to Corstorphine Hill (opposite Balgreen Road) where we aim to arrive by 10.30am.

We will then follow the path up the hill around Edinburgh Zoo to reach Clermiston Tower at approximately 11am.

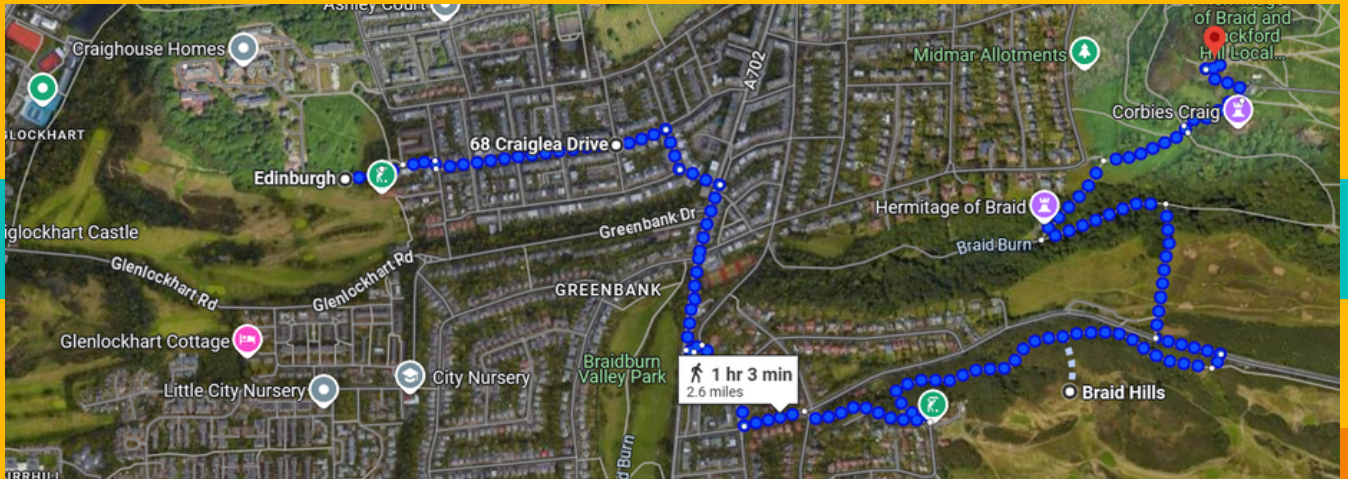


We will travel to Craiglockhart Hill (Hill 4) via the following route:

- Kaimes Road
- Carrick Knowe Avenue
- Stenhouse Drive
- Gorgie Road
- Chesser Avenue
- Slateford Road
- Allan Park Road
- Craiglockhart Road North

We will access Craiglockhart Hill East via Craiglockhart Sports Centre

★ LEG 3 ★

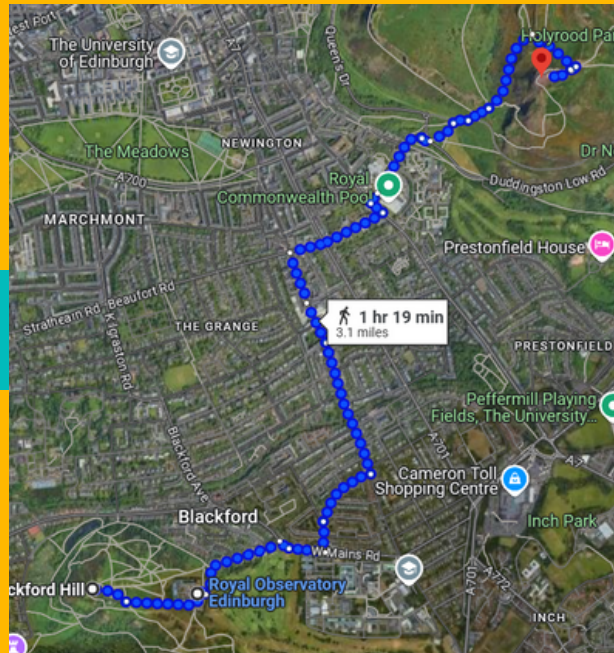


We will aim to leave from the top of Craiglockhart Hill East at 12 Noon

We will descend the hill via the former Napier University Campus at Craighouse and take Craiglea Drive to Greenbank Terrace and Braid Road, walking up Braid Hill (Hill 5) from Braid Hills Road

We will then take the Lang Linn Path and cross the Braid Burn to climb Blackford Hill (Hill 6)

★ LEG 4 ★



We will aim to leave from the top of Blackford Hill at 1.30pm.

We will descend via the Observatory before travelling to our final hill, Arthur's Seat via:

- Observatory Road
- Blackford Avenue
- Lussielaw Road
- Mayfield Road
- Salisbury Road
- Holyrood Park Road
